ORDER

Appellants have filed a motion to compel compliance with this court's order of December 15, 2016, which stayed the issuance of two certifications by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control. Appellants allege Horry County is refusing to cease construction activities relating to the road project. To the extent that Horry County needs clarification of that order, this court reiterates that it imposed a stay pursuant to Rule 241(c)(2) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Because this court stayed the issuance of the certifications that "authorize Horry County to build a highway within and adjacent to Lewis Ocean Bay Heritage Preserve in Horry County," the order requires that Horry County halt all work on the road project, including the widening, paving, and realigning of the existing unimproved portion of International Drive, pending the resolution of this appeal or other proceedings of this court.
